Joint Statement

It is the first time we consider very carefully the resolution relating to human rights issues in Vietnam which was adopted by European Parliament having many countries as members.

All the points contained in the resolution have reflected the truth, depth and reality. It is the resolution passed through very clear and precise study and research made by the specialists.

Vietnamese government has always rejected its negative events and never recognized the truth. These are from the Vietnamese leaders' attitudes have always maintained the vision and pride of a narrow culture -that is all ethnic minority groups in Vietnam have to be under influence of the potential and opulent ethnic Kinh.

Vietnamese government is not willing to give up the racial politics and persecution over those who have different political opinion. Actually, the religious groups and other ethnic

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minority groups in Vietnam have ever suffered serious violations. Specifically, what should be further remarked is that there were 63 different ethnic minority groups in Vietnam, but now only from 57-54 ethnic minority groups remaining. This decreased number is not a positive factor.

In the 1960s and 1970s, Vietnamese factions fought against each other; it was the time for Vietnam to console ethnic Khmer for political gains. So, at that time, ethnic Khmer enjoyed better religious belief and education if compared to the present situation.

It is complained that Khmer Buddhist leaders in some pagodas have been full of fear, religious activities have been interfered by Vietnamese authorities and many forms were lost. The monks in some pagodas were defrocked and also sentenced to prison for their expression relevant to religious belief.

Another point to be noted is that in the Khmer National Committee, even its leader has also been controlled by a high-ranking official originated from ethnic Kinh.

It is our understanding that Vietnamese government should try to build self-reliance with integrity for all different ethnic groups without tricks.

We wish to completely and strongly support the contents of the European Parliament's resolution.
